All attendees are asked to organise their own travel to Cambridge for the Retreat.

Bv Train

A coach shuttle service from Cambridge train station to Robinson College is available for attendees travelling by train. The coach journey takes around 15 minutes, and will depart from Cambridge Station for Robinson College at approximately 10.45, 11.15 and 11.45 on 11th July.

There will also be a coach shuttle provided for attendees leaving Robinson College to take the train from Cambridge Station at the end of the ISMB Retreat on Friday 12th July at approximately 13.15, 13.45 and 14.15, which hopefully will also connect to trains back to London.

A car parking space has been booked for attendees that indicated that they would be travelling by car on their registration form. They will be sent a permit and details separately by email.

Check-in and Registration

On arrival at Robinson College, attendees will enter via the Porter's Lodge. At the lodge, overnight guests will need to complete a registration form to receive their room key.



Registration for the Retreat itself will be from 11:30 to 12:00 in the Auditorium foyer at Robinson College, on the opposite side of the court yard from the Porter's Lodge. You will be provided with a name badge, programme, list of posters and attendee list.

Meals

A buffet lunch will be provided on arrival on 11th July and before departure on 12th July. The evening meal on 11th July will be served from 18.30 in the Dining Hall. Breakfast on 12th July and the two

buffet lunches are served in the Garden Restaurant.

If you have advised of any dietary requirements in your registration form, please identify yourself to serving staff in the dining hall and they will provide your meal.

Poster presentations

The poster session will take place in the Dining Hall in the evening of Thursday 11th July (after dinner from 20.00 to 22.00). All poster presenters should please mount their posters during the free time before or during dinner. The boards will be in place in the Dining Hall from arrival. Presenters will be advised of their poster board numbers separately and they will be available at the venue.

The poster boards are 3 ft high x 4 ft wide (0.9m x 1.20m - AO). Posters can be attached with Velcro or pins. Pins will be available for you to use, but please bring your own Velcro if you would prefer to use it.
